National Conference ABAS-2017

A two-day ICMR sponsored National Conference "ABAS-2017" has been organized by School of Basic

and Applied Sciences w.e.f. 07th to 8th April, 2017. The conference was inaugurated by Prof R L Sharma, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Himachal Pradesh Technical University, Hamirpur and Prof P L Gautam, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Career Point University, Hamirpur. In his opening speech, Prof R L Sharma insisted on the importance of qualitative work and said that researchers must have patient while completing their work to avoid any complications.



On first day, well reputed scientist Prof Ravi Kumar (NIT Hamirpur), Dr Satinder (IIT Mandi), Prof P L Sharma (HPU) and Prof M S Chauhan (HPU) shared their knowledge and experience while delivering their invited talks. Prof Ravi Kumar briefed about Material Science and motivated researchers to explore this field.

The conference was attended by more than 200 research scholars who came up from many esteemed universities such as Kathmandu University Nepal, Guru Nanak Dev University Amritsar, Kurukshetra University Haryana,

and Amity University Gwalior. These scholars presented their research by means of oral and poster presentations.



On 8th April 2017, Prof Rup Lal was invited as the chief guest for closing ceremony. The closing ceremony was blessed with the gracious presence of some of the well-known scientists of India such as Prof Suman Lakhanpal (Delhi University), Prof Gurinderjit Randhawa (ICAR, Delhi), Prof D C Gautam (HPU), Prof P C Sharma and Prof Kamal Sharma (College of Horticulture and Forestry Neri, Hamirpur). During this conference about 198 research papers were received from various fields. Out of which there were 79 poster and 119 oral presentations. Among all of these papers, the Scientific Committee selected only 30 research papers based on the quality content, which will be published online in the Career Point University's Research Journal.

At the end, chief guest Prof Rup Lal addressed the students and encouraged them to come forward with new ideas and make their institution, state and country proud. A Visit to Herbal Garden JoginderNagar

During their visit, students collected information about different herbs like Aswagandha, Gooseberry, Sita Ashok Varveris, Azadirachta Indica, Erica Cactus, Cycas and some plants which are likely to extinct like Jigon, Valova and some useful plants like, Ficus Religiosa (Pipal), Gooseberry (Aanwla), etc.



Students also collected samples of Briofite, Gymnosperm and Angiosperm for the laboratories. The University insists on such visits which are quite beneficial for students as it imparts practical knowledge among them by obtaining knowledge direct form field.
