From upcoming academic session, Career Point University is starting degree programs in new courses viz. Fashion Technology, Bio Informatics, Forensic Science, Food Science, Journalism, B.Voc, Electrical Engineering and B. Pharmacy. The University has obtained all the necessary permissions from Regulatory Commission, Himachal Pradesh. Prof. M.R. Sharma, Dean Academic Affairs told that, the course Fashion Technology will run for three years and students from both, medical and non-medical background can apply for it. The university is also starting B.Sc. and M.Sc. courses in Microbiology. Apart from this, a three year program in the fields of Automobile, IT, Construction Management are also getting started as well. All these courses will start from the academic session 2017-2018. University has also increased seats in the already running courses such as B.Tech./M.Tech. (Mechanical & Civil), MCA, BCA, MBA, B.Sc./M.Sc. (Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Math, & Zoology) and BHMCT.
