



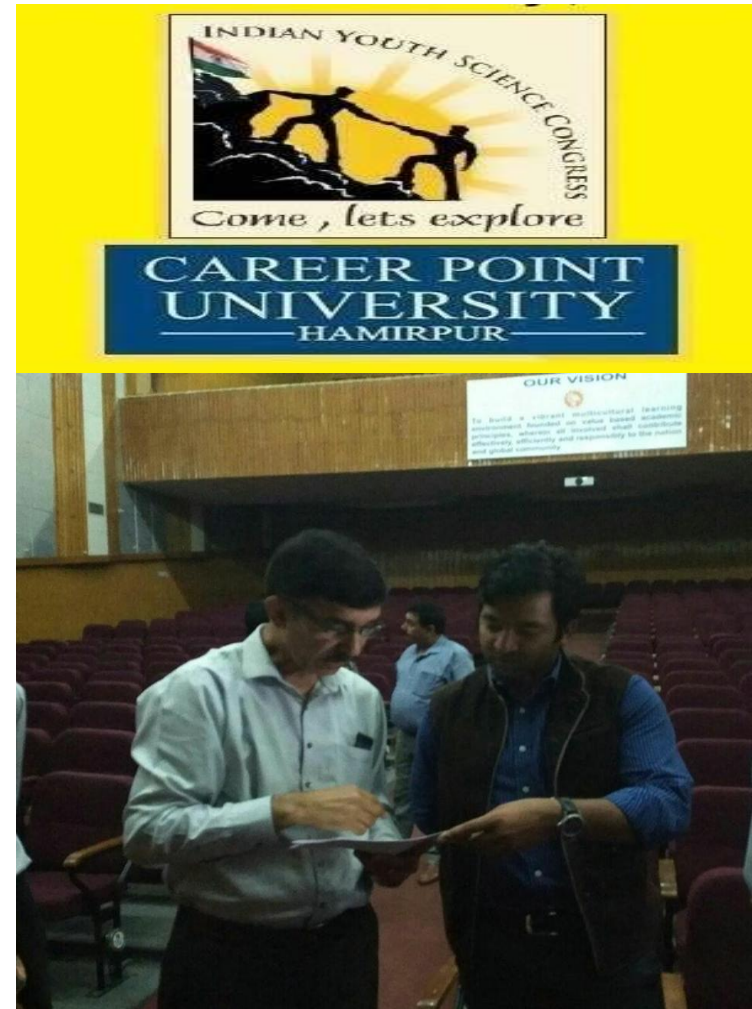

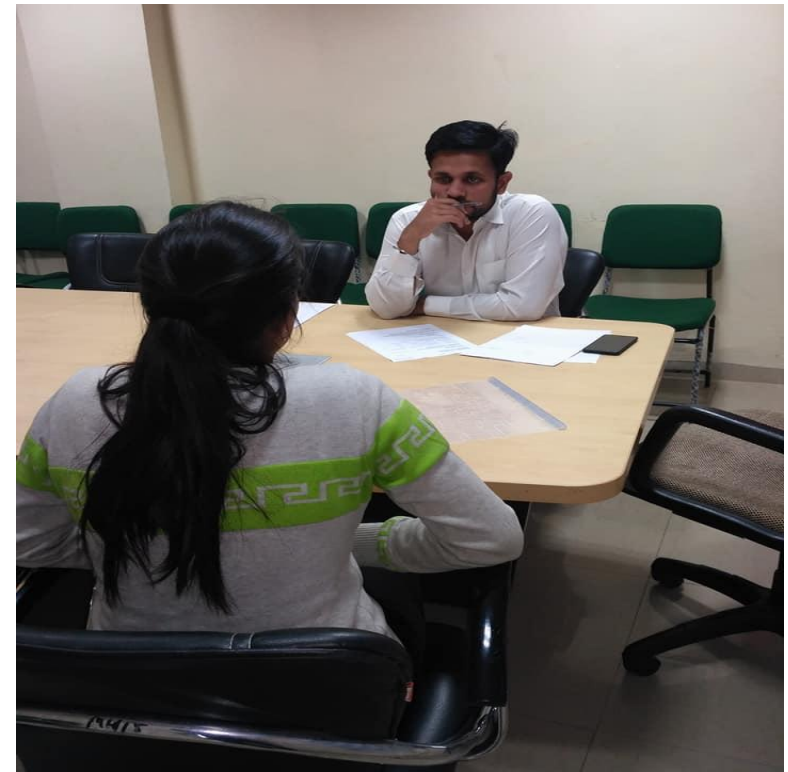
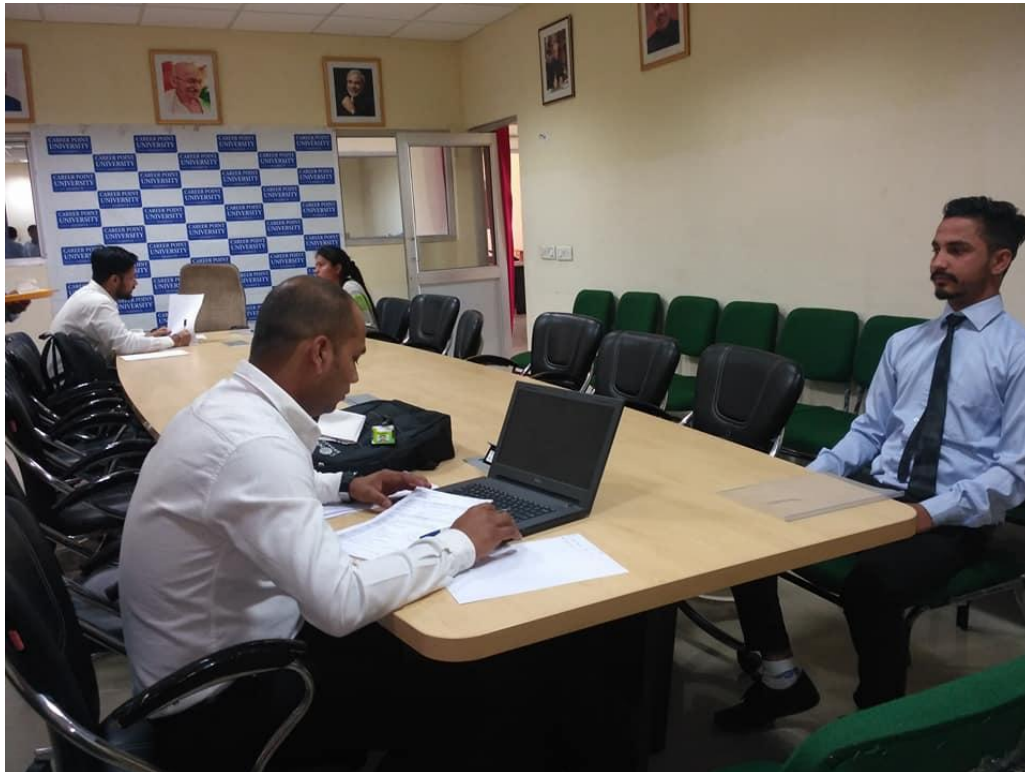
Environment in University Campus during Examination

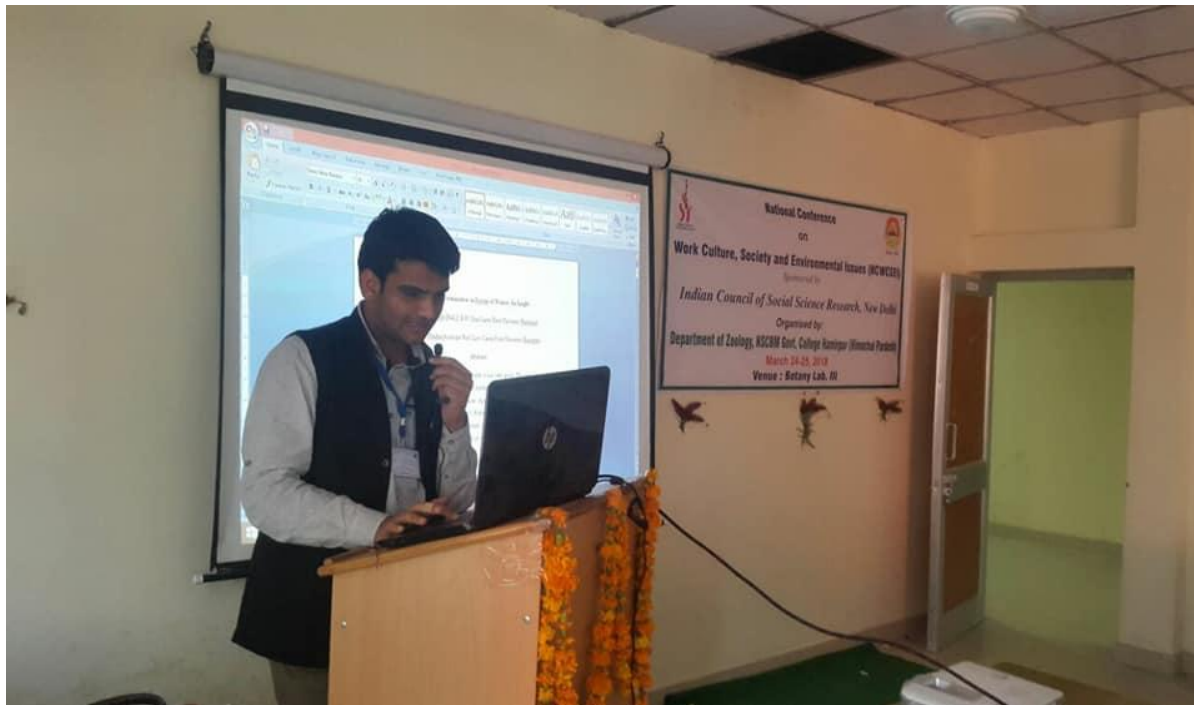
Campus placement drive in Career Point University, Hamirpur
