The students of the Department of Botany were detailed to visit Botanical Garden at Jogindernagar on 01.05.2016 for gaining practical knowledge. In the garden they saw various medicinal and aromatic plants namely: *Withania somnifera* (Ashvagnidha), *Saraca asoca* (Sita Ashoka), *Azadirachta indica* (Neem), *Terminalia chebula* (Harad), *Opuntia* (Cactus), and *Cycus*. Extinct species of plants viz. Pipal, *Phyllanthus*, and *Embllica* (Amla) were also available in the garden. At Barot, students collected the samples of *Brayophytes*, *Gymnosperms* and *Angiosperms* for laboratory practicals.
