The main objective of this webinar was to spread awareness regarding Cyber Crime against women. Especially discussion has gone to Cyber Crime Against Women during Covid -19. Prof. Preeti Sexena, the Director Post Graduate Legal Studies and Head School of Legal Studies Baba Saheb BhimRao Ambedker Central University, Lukhnow was the Guest of Honour of this webinar. Dr Shiv Kumar, Commandant of Home Guard Himachal Pradesh Police Solan has also chaired the first session about Cyber Crime against women. In second session, Dr. Anita Ganapati from Computer Science Department, Himachal Pradesh Shimla talked about how women must save her from the internet cyber crimes during digital communication. Farmers Training cum Awareness Program organized by Division Botany and sponsored by Pioneer Incubator Cell of Career Point University Hamirpur for a week (22.12.2020 - 28.12.2020) on “Commercialization of Edible and Medicinal Plants of District Hamirpur (H. P.)”. That Training was inaugurated by the Chief Guest, Prof. K.S. Verma (the Hon’ble Vice Chancellor, Career Point University Hamirpur). The farmers trained about the raising and caring of orchid, importance of fertilizers for plants and also talked about the strategies that can be used to prevent or control plant diseases. All the participants were trained by the experts for the different processed food products such as *jam, chutney, candies, pickle, sweets* etc. from *papaya, lemon, Indian gooseberry, apple* etc. The experts also explained the role of medicinal plant such as *Emblica officinalis, Withania Somnifera, Bacopa monnieri, Tinospora Cordifolio, Ocimum Sanctum, Terminalia chebula, Terminalia bellerica* etc. in boosting immunity and preventing or curing diseases. A booklet on “Importance of Medicinal Plants of Hamirpur Region” was also released by the Chief Guest. At the end of session, Dr. Arti Sharma (Head, Bio Sciences) recapitulated the main activities done during the one week training program and felicitated all the participants. Waste Collection Unit Installed in the Temple of Ladrour under the Department of Environment Science and Technology , Government of Himachal Pradesh, India

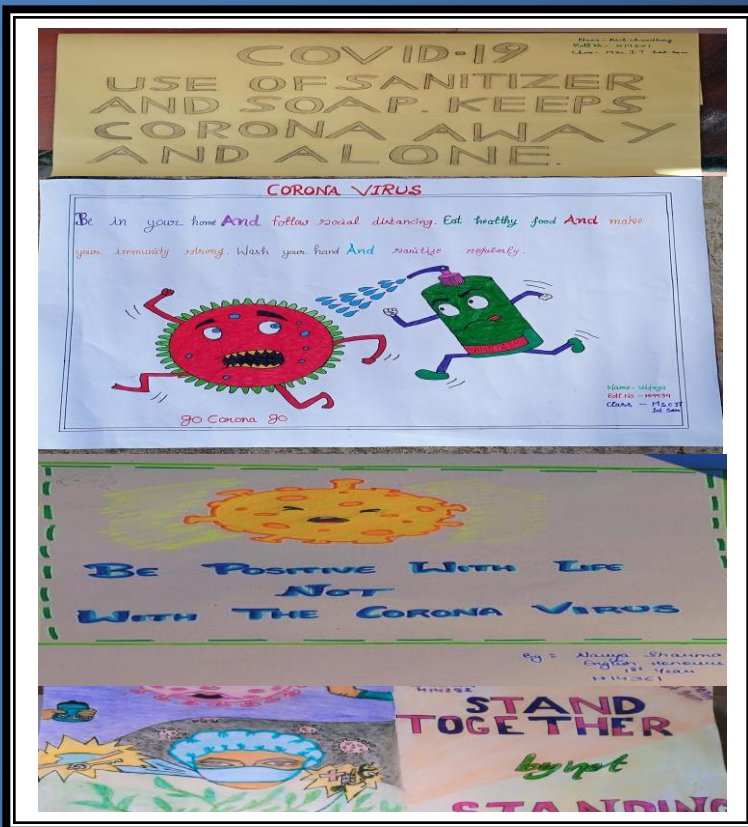
