



Seminar on Educational Values and Technologies

A one-day seminar on “Educational Values and Technologies” was held at Career Point University Hamirpur on 7th February, 2017. Prof Verma discussed about the meaning, need and various applications of Computer Algebra Systems (CAS). He briefed that CAS are special kind of mathematical applications and provides users means for

doing symbolic, algebraic and graphical manipulations with computers. He demonstrated the power of solving complex problems also updated that its use in mathematics teaching is in its infancy in India. The talk by Prof Verma was rejoiced by all.
